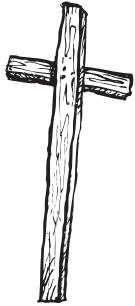




How to build a SCARECROW



Build a frame

Use a piece of wood (scrap wood, broom handle, rake handle, pole, etc.) Center this piece vertically on another horizontal piece of wood.



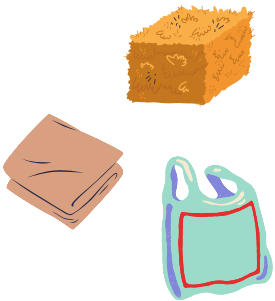
Put cloths on your frame

Use an old long sleeve shirt (scarecrows look best in flannel!) and some jeans for the legs, gloves for the hands, and old shoes or boots for the feet. These can be pinned or sewn on. Use burlap, a pumpkin, or a pillowcase for the head.



Stuff, stuff, stuff!

Stuff the head, pants, shirt, gloves, and shoes with straw, old cloth sheets, plastic bags, or whatever you have laying around the house.



Finishing touches...

Create a face for your scarecrow by drawing on the head with a permanent marker, using buttons for eyes, glueing cut out pieces of cloth, or anything you have laying around.
